The purpose of the Hills-Beaver Creeks Bands is to promote excellence in education and in musicianship through performance. Participation in the H-BC Bands fulfills and meets a number of different National Music Standards as set down by the National Association for Music Education (NAfME).

MATERIALS REQUIRED

- Pencil for every rehearsal
- Instrument, and all necessary supplies (reeds, sticks, valve oil and other materials can be purchased before or after school, or during lesson times)
- Woodwind players: must have 2-3 reeds in good shape at all times
- Brass players: you must supply your own valve oil, slide grease, etc.
- Percussionists: you must supply your own pair of snare drum sticks

COVID-19

- Bell Covers including *Merv 13* air filtration material will be provided for all wind players
- Flute Players will be provided a "Win-D-Fender" air guard and Merv 13 material
- Woodwind and Brass players will wear masks modified for playing. This adapted mask will be used for band class only.
- Brass instruments will be provided absorbent pads to empty their water valves
- Percussionists may wear regular face coverings
- Students will be spaced six feet apart. Trombones will be spaced nine feet apart (due to the length of the slide)

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

- •Electronic devices must be left in your storage space or locker. They are not allowed during rehearsal.
- •Arrive to class on time. After the tardy bell, you have 3 minutes to be seated with your instrument and music and ready to play.
- No gum, candy or beverages in the classroom (water in a clear bottle is permitted).
- Have your instrument, music and pencil ready to go every day.
- Respect the people, equipment and furnishings of the band room. This includes keeping your storage space organized and free of garbage.
